



DENVER INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

FACT SHEET

Denver International Airport (DEN) has approximately 53 square miles of land area— the second-largest airport property in the world. DEN also has the largest commercial development opportunity connected to any airport in the United States.

NOTABLE STATS

- DEN is the third-busiest airport in the U.S. and the sixth-busiest airport in the world by total passengers. (Source: ACI YTD Nov 2024 Rankings)
- DEN served a record 82,358,744 passengers in 2024, a 5.8% increase over the 77,837,917 passengers served in 2023, the previous record. (Source: DEN internal statistics)
- Annual economic impact: \$47.2B total impact, supporting 244,000 jobs. (Source: 2025 Colorado Aviation Economic Impact Study)
- 1,835 average daily flights (2024)
- 27 commercial airlines (2025)
- 225 nonstop destinations (2025)
- 192 nonstop domestic destinations across 46 U.S. states and 1 U.S. territory
- 33 nonstop international destinations in 18 countries

More than 41,000 badged employees (city, airlines, vendors, contractors and tenants)

CONCESSIONS

- More than 200 concession locations, including global brands and local favorites
- More than 250,000 square feet of concession space across the airport

FACILITIES

- Six runways; five are 12,000 feet in length and 150 feet wide; one is 16,000 feet in length and 200 feet wide.
- DEN has more than 250 pieces of snow removal equipment.
- DEN can clear a runway in an average of 15-17 minutes.
- DEN Tower (FAA ATC) is 327 feet tall.
